

- Professional Recognition: Upon completion, earn an internationally recognized Badge to display on your LinkedIn profile. This course is also the first of six leading to an internationally recognized Certificate in One Health.

Target Audience

This course is ideal for 1. Professionals currently working in One Health sectors, including government, non-profits, academia, and private industries, 2. Individuals seeking to enhance their interdisciplinary problem-solving skills and learn how to apply the One Health approach in their professional fields, and 3. Professionals wanting to develop leadership skills in coordinating and managing cross-sector health initiatives.

Course Structure

This seven-week course requires 6-10 hours per week and is designed to fit around your schedule. The first five weeks are delivered asynchronously, meaning you can engage with the material at any time, including:

- Mini-Lectures: Two to three 5-minute videos each week
- Short readings and scientific papers
- Interactive group assignments
- Discussion posts and reflections

Participants are assigned to interdisciplinary groups and will work together throughout the course. The final two weeks focus on a group project where participants apply their learning to a comprehensive case study, allowing you to collaborate with your peers in a virtual forum.

Time Commitment

Duration: Seven weeks

Hours per Week: 6-10 hours. The course offers flexibility to fit into your work schedule, while the final group project can be done asynchronously or with optional virtual meetings to enhance collaboration.
