He has 40 years' experience in senior positions in the biotechnology industry and played a leading role in the development of five vaccines now licensed against Ebola, dengue, Japanese encephalitis and smallpox and a veterinary vaccine against West Nile virus. Before joining industry, Tom served in the US Army and US Public Health Service for 24 years. He was Director, Division of Vector-Borne Viral Diseases at the Centers for Disease Control and Chief of the Virology Division at USAMRIID. Sabin Gold Medal, and has served on numerous government and international committees on infectious diseases, biosecurity, WHO expert committees and the National Vaccines Advisory Committee
